

RECAP: NSBE's 10th Annual Professional Development Conference

The 10th Annual Professional Development Conference (PDC) was an extraordinary success, featuring more than 45 engaging workshops, networking events and certification opportunities, all centered on the theme "Embracing the New A.G.E."

The conference focused on the need for STEM professionals to *Adapt* to today's changing circumstances and the "new normal," *Grow* in response to challenges and new innovations and *Evolve* in performance to achieve success in a rapidly changing ecosystem.

Following full-day, industry-led training sessions on leading-edge technologies including AI and ORD, the Opening Session of the conference on Aug. 23 was truly memorable, thanks to the inspiring keynote speaker, Janeen Uzzell, CEO of NSBE, and an impressive lineup of special guests. Other notable figures who participated in the conference included Mayor Bruce Arfsten of Addison, Texas; Mayor Eric L. Johnson of Dallas, Texas; multitalented actor, entrepreneur and tech aficionado Brian J. White; and charismatic talk show and radio personality Claudia Jordan.

The culminating Evening of Excellence Gala, honoring outstanding career achievement and community service, was a huge success, as was the Back-to-School Expo, a community event that aimed to spark interest in STEM careers for K-12 students in local neighborhoods, while providing them with needed supplies for the upcoming year. The NSBE Golf Classic, held during the PDC, raised funds for scholarships for continuing education for graduate students and STEM professionals.
